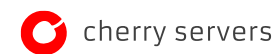

The Baltic States

The Baltic States — Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania — sit on the eastern shore of the Baltic Sea and have a combined population of just six million people. We're small in size but powerful in impact.

Internet & Technology Edge

- Among the world leaders in internet penetration and speed:
 - Estonia ~94% users, Latvia ~90%, Lithuania ~95%.
 - Regional broadband and FTTP coverage ranks among the highest in the EU.

Startup Ecosystem

- The region is a startup powerhouse relative to size:
 - Estonia: ~1,300 startups, seven unicorns
 - Lithuania: ~900 startups, three unicorns
 - Latvia: ~600 startups

In 2023, Baltic startups raised \$517M in funding despite the global downturn. Estonia has a high per-capita startup density and ranks among the top in the world.

Vilnius, Lithuania

Vilnius isn't just our capital — it's the region's innovation engine, blending history, culture, and cutting-edge digital growth.

Interesting Facts

- Capital of Lithuania with ~600,000 residents — the largest city in the Baltics
- Generates ~50% of Lithuania's GDP and 90% of startup enterprise value
- Known as the “Silicon Valley of the Baltics”, a hub for fintech, cybersecurity & digital infrastructure
- Transforming old industrial spaces into major tech campuses
- Among Europe's most livable, affordable, and digitally connected cities — a natural host for BalticNOG

BalticNOG Journey

BalticNOG will move from Vilnius to Riga to Tallinn, ensuring each capital becomes a focal point for knowledge sharing and collaboration. By rotating annually, we strengthen regional ties and build a united Baltic internet community.

The Road Ahead for BalticNOG

- **2025** – Vilnius → Our first gathering, where it all begins
- **2026** – Riga → Expanding the community across Latvia
- **2027** – Tallinn → Bringing BalticNOG to Estonia

BalticNOG is a rotating event — uniting the region, one capital at a time.
